

Your Guide to Dreaming Summit Bulk Trash Services for Residential Customers

Bulk trash is material that cannot be placed into the garbage container such as furniture, some appliances, and large amounts of vegetation.

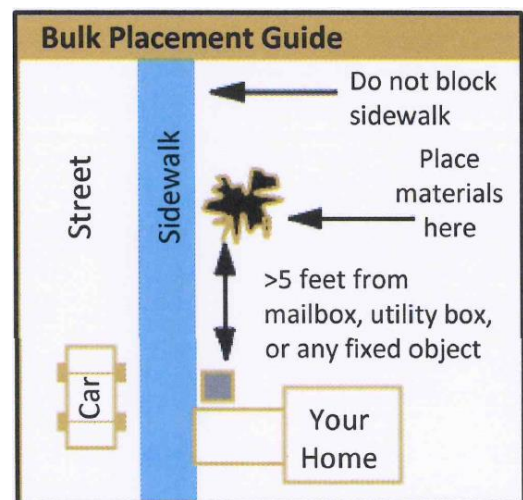
For efficient and timely collection, your bulk trash pile should not exceed 6 cubic yards (6ft high x 6ft wide x 6ft deep) in size.

All debris should be neatly stacked, bagged and tied.

You may place debris on a tarp.

The bulk trash pile must be placed at least 5 feet from any fixed object, such as utility poles, mailboxes, parked cars, or other objects.

Good to go!

- Furniture
- Some appliances (hazardous chemicals removed)
- Large vegetation less than 4 feet in length and 12 inches in diameter, which have been tied and bundled
- Small vegetation, such as grass clippings and leaves, should be bagged and placed in the regular trash container

No thanks!

- Household hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, oil)
- Loose vegetation that is not bagged or bundled
- Bricks, concrete, dirt or similar materials
- Construction material in excess of 25 pounds and longer than 4 feet in length; and materials generated by a contractor
- Metal, rebar, and fence posts
- Tires, automobile wheels or parts
- Glass such as windows and mirrors
- Appliances containing refrigerants or other hazardous chemicals.
